It may be an actual machine or a false memory. The events viewed are either real (as in films and video games) or real events viewed by the user, either by his or her own mind or by some device. It may also allow the user to travel back in time. A time machine may be used to travel into the future and into alternate timelines, though this requires more advanced technology than most time machines. The first fictional time machine was the monorail invented by Isaac Asimov in his short story "The Bicentennial Man". In the story, the time traveler takes a detour and changes history by not going to the future but to Earth's past instead, in the year 2036. The first sci-fi film to deal with time travel was in the 1936 German film *Das Mann ohne Eigenschaften* (The Man without Qualities) by Fritz Lang, in which the main character is shown traveling forward and backward in time. The concept of a time machine with moving parts was popularized by H. G. Wells in his 1898 science fiction novel *The Time Machine*. The story of a time traveler from the 19th century venturing into the future was popularized by HG Wells, and was revived by several American science fiction authors of the 1920s, who were influenced by Wells' work. The first practical time machine was built in 1896 by the British physicist John Titor, who claimed he could travel to 2036. In his book *I Am The Time Traveller*, Titor wrote, "The scientist who invents a time machine could change history." Titor sent himself emails to the future every day, starting in 1997, and was arrested in December 1999 for sending a bomb threat. T 82157476af
